

Since 1981, Family House has served as a home away from home for families of children with cancer and other life-threatening illnesses by providing physical comfort and emotional support, free from financial concerns. The Nancy and Stephen Grand Family House is located just a few blocks from the UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital in Mission Bay. With cancer treatment taking weeks, months, or even years, Family House is an oasis for children and families going through an extremely difficult time. Family House provides compassionate housing, amenities, and support for up to 80 families per night, always 100% free of charge, thanks to generous donor and volunteer support.

George Hamel often jokes that "family" is so important to his wife Pam and him that it is literally the middle of the name of the business that they started together in 2014. Hamel Family Wines is in the heart of Sonoma Valley. All four of Pam and George's children have worked at the winery at one time or another, their three sons all met their wives through the business, and their middle son John oversees the winegrowing and winemaking.

Driven by a desire to showcase their distinctive estate vineyard sites and emphasized by dry farming, biodynamic and organic farming practices, the Hamel team crafts wines that express the distinctive characteristics of the vineyards' terroir.

When wildfires swept through wine country in 2017, Pam and George sprang into action. They quickly organized and hosted a benefit with singer John Fogerty in support of Wine Country Wildfire Relief, raising more than \$1.3 million. For the Hamels, who lost their own home in the fire, it was a typical act of generosity. When the son of family friends was diagnosed with a brain tumor, the Hamels wasted no time in fundraising on behalf of the McKenzie family, ensuring that 100% of Kate and Matt's attention could be focused on helping Frankie to get well again.

Family is everything for Pam and George Hamel, and we are proud and grateful to call them, their four children and now four grandchildren (and—if Pam and George have any say—still counting), a part of ours.



"Brain tumor" might be two of the worst words imaginable for a family to hear from a doctor, and for then-3-year-old Frankie's parents, they knew they had a fight ahead of them. After Frankie's diagnosis, he endured brain surgery, six weeks of radiation, and three different stem cell transplants at UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital—two hours away from their home

in Santa Rosa. Thanks to friends Pamela and George Hamel, they quickly moved into Family House, and stayed for the better part of a year while he received treatment. The connections they made at Family House were invaluable. "Parents here can relate to each other through incredibly difficult situations."

Seven years after his diagnosis, Frankie continues to amaze everyone with his growth. He's tall and eats like a champion. His cancer is most likely gone, but the effects of treatment keep the family on their toes.

"We are thankful every day that we have our beautiful boy."

Frankie's cheerful and resilient spirit inspires positivity, and reminds the McKenzie family daily that they have been blessed through this entire journey. "We have so much support and love from his doctors, our family, our community and of course Family House, the place Frankie begs to stay for every office visit we have in the city."
