The night featured a festive cocktail reception with a violin performance by Shaina Evoniuk of Eclecta Strings, gourmet appetizers, dinner, and late night bites by McCalls Catering, an "Afterglow" at Holbrook House following the finely curated live auction with celebrity Auctioneer Christopher Hanke, and so much more.

"When families walk through our doors, they find a community of Family House Magic, and our incredible gala community embodies that spirit of support and care," said Family House Chief Executive Office Katherine Thompson. "We are grateful to everyone who supported this extraordinary gala! Gratitude has a loving home in Family House and we appreciate our generous community."

Since 1981, Family House San Francisco has provided free housing and basic needs for the families of seriously ill young patients being treated at UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital. Located in San Francisco's Mission Bay neighborhood, Family House San Francisco is a five-story, 80-bedroom facility that houses up to 350 people per night. Family House San Francisco is a free home away from home and a supportive community dedicated to providing a caring environment for the entire family while their child is undergoing treatment.
